### **Job Approval, Senator Mark Kirk**

*Now, I'd like for you to tell me how well Senator Mark Kirk is doing his job? Do you strongly approve, somewhat approve, somewhat disapprove, or strongly disapprove of the job Senator Kirk is doing?*

<b>Response</b>	<b>Percent (n=1000)</b>
Approve	39%
Neither	5%
Disapprove	31%
Other/Don't Know	25%

Note: values are rounded.

### **Job Approval, Senator Dick Durbin**

*Next, I'd like for you to tell me how well Senator Dick Durbin is doing his job? Do you strongly approve, somewhat approve, somewhat disapprove, or strongly disapprove of the job Senator Durbin is doing?*

<b>Response</b>	<b>Percent (n=1000)</b>
Approve	51%
Neither	4%
Disapprove	34%
Other/Don't Know	12%

## Frequency Tables

### **U.S. Senate Primary, Democratic**

*If the Democratic primary for U.S. Senate were held today, would you vote for Tammy Duckworth, Andrea Zopp, or Napoleon Harris?*

<b>Response</b>	<b>Percent (n=422)</b>
Tammy Duckworth	52%
Andrea Zopp	6%
Napoleon Harris	4%
Someone else (not read)	0%
Other/Don't know (not read)	37%

Note: the order that names were read was rotated. The question was only asked of those who said they planned to vote Democratic. Values are rounded so do not sum to 100%.

### **U.S. Senate Primary, Republican**

*If the Republican primary for U.S. Senator were held today, would you vote for Mark Kirk or James Marter?*

<b>Response</b>	<b>Percent (n=306)</b>
Mark Kirk	53%
James Marter	14%
Someone else (not read)	0%
Other/Don't know (not read)	33%

Note: the order that names were read was rotated. The question was only asked of those who said they planned to vote Republican.
