RADHIKA RAO is Professor of Law and Harry & Lillian Hastings Research Chair at UC College of the Law San Francisco. She earned her J.D. *magna cum laude* from Harvard Law School and was Supreme Court Editor of the *Harvard Law Review*. She then clerked for Justices Harry Blackmun and Thurgood Marshall at the Supreme Court. She has been a visiting professor at Brooklyn Law School and the University of Michigan Law School, and a Fulbright Distinguished Professor at the University of Trento in Italy. Her publications include *Property, Privacy, and the Human Body; Equal Liberty: Assisted Reproductive Technology and Reproductive Equality; Informed Consent, Body Property, and Self-Sovereignty; and Selective Reduction: "A Soft Cover for Hard Choices" or Another Name for Abortion*. She also wrote the entry on abortion for the Max Planck Encyclopedia of Comparative Constitutional Law. She has served as a member of the California Advisory Committee on Human Cloning, and currently serves on the California Human Stem Cell Research Advisory Committee.
