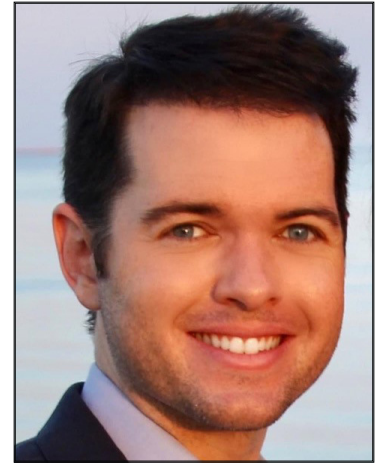
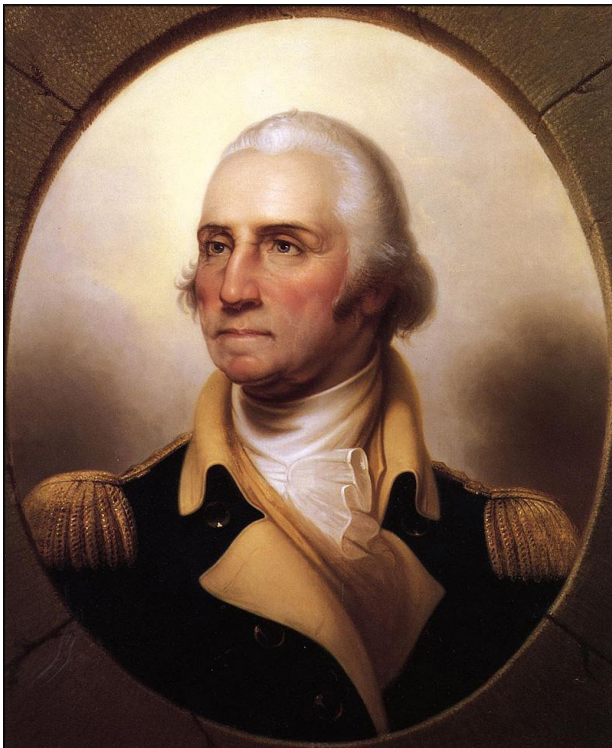

LOGAN BEIRNE

(pronounced “Burn”) is a Faculty Fellow & Lecturer in Law at Yale Law School. He founded Matterhorn Transactions, Inc., a legal information services company that provides deal term analytics to thousands of law firms across the US, UK, and Canada, and sold the company to DealPulse, Inc. in 2023. He was previously an associate at Sullivan & Cromwell LLP. He earned a B.S. in Finance at Fairfield University, was a Fulbright Scholar at Queen’s University, and received a J.D. from Yale Law School.

Logan published the bestselling book *Blood of Tyrants: George Washington & the Forging of the Presidency*, which was selected for the Colby Award and the Lincoln Medal. The book explores how the battlefield decisions of the Founders continue to shape the meaning of the U.S. Constitution. He is also a co-author of the textbook *Iconic Cases in Corporate Law*. Logan and his writings have been featured by *The New York Times*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *USA Today*, Reuters, *National Review*, and other media outlets.
